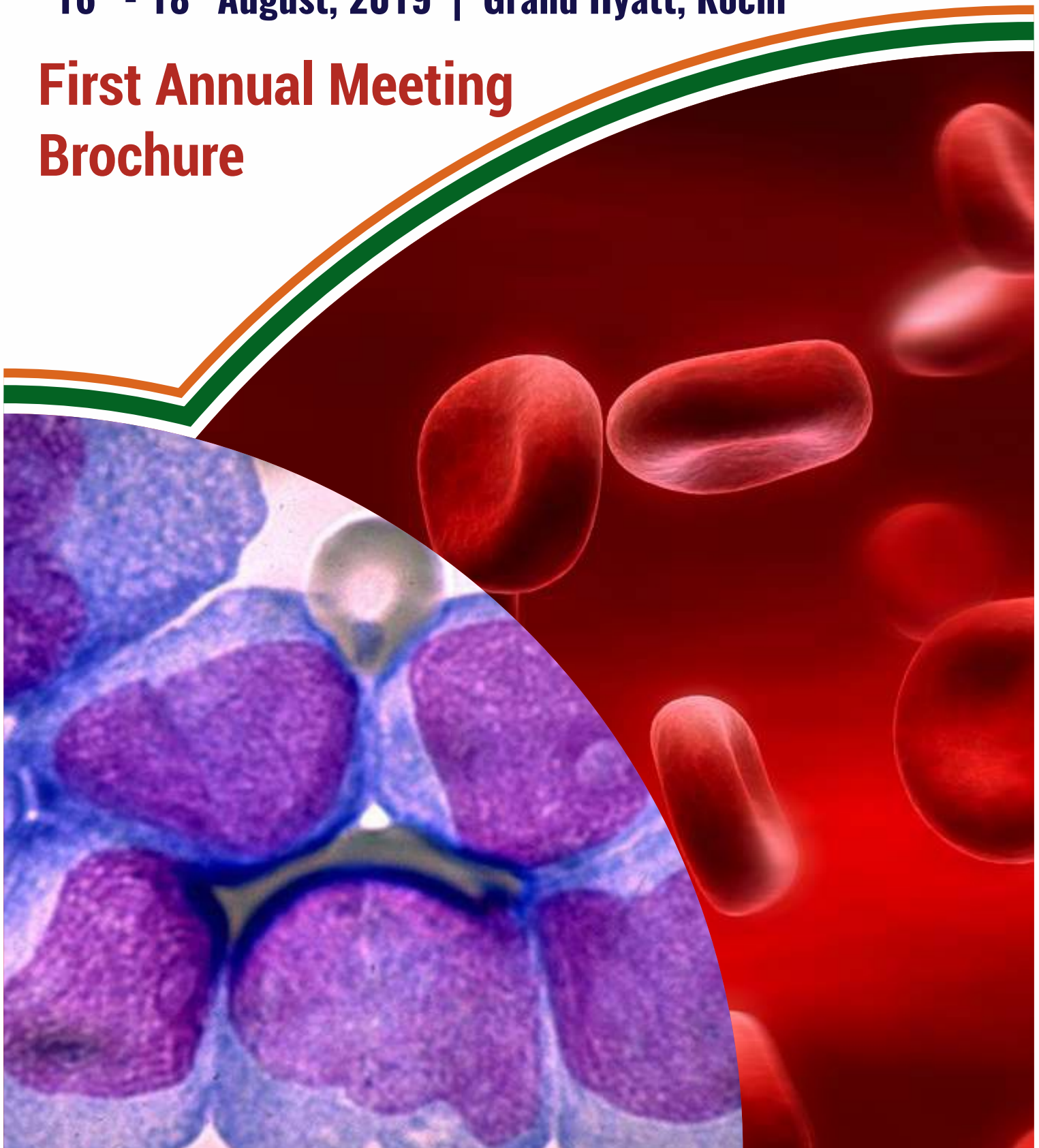

In the first year of its existence the consortium has established collaborative database for acute leukemia's and has started the process for conducting prospective investigator-initiated studies.

## Highlights of the Meeting

The annual meeting will focus on acute myeloid leukemia, acute promyelocytic leukemia, acute lymphoblastic leukemia, chronic myeloid leukemia, myelodysplastic syndrome and multiple myeloma. International and national experts will present the critical appraisal of emerging and existing data and its applicability in the day to day practice. An important focus of this meeting will be the trainees' education with the help of multi-disciplinary sessions addressing the diagnosis, prognostication and therapy of haematological cancers. This meeting will showcase the data on acute leukemia's from the Indian centers. The poster session will provide an opportunity to present data pertaining to diagnosis, treatment, novel findings and clinical outcomes in hematological cancers. The unique aspect is the session focusing on novel research concepts and ideas relevant to the country.
